

REMEMBER!

Les Petits Chaperons Rouges offers three attendance options: regular, occasional or emergency care.

Even if you have a other childcare, you can request emergency childcare in one of our network nurseries if required. This service is open to all employees!

The confirmation form

This document lays out the rules on nursery access and retaining your place as a company employee. The form should be duly completed and signed, then sent back within ten (10) working days.



The internal guidelines*

The guidelines explain how the nursery works and detail the rules to follow when using our services. You will be asked to sign the document at the nursery, during your admission appointment.



The contract

This document sets out your child's attendance schedule at the nursery and accordingly informs you of the amount to be invoiced to you monthly



REMEMBER!

JOINING THE NURSERY

Our nurseries comply with the applicable standards on hygiene, safety and access for people with disabilities. In addition, each nursery has received approval from the French state child welfare service (PMI), which carries out regular inspections.

The design and layout of our facilities encourage your child's early learning and development, with special water games areas, sensory rooms, breast-feeding rooms, dormitories, and more.

At Les Petits Chaperons Rouges, we strongly believe in parents as partners – that a child's development is largely improved when parents and the nursery work closely together. For us, trustful relationships are built through care and effective communication

Good communication is developed during specific key moments:



- During the settling-in period
- When sharing information at the start and end of the day
- During individual appointments
- At group meetings
- At festive events at the nursery

Pursuant to the French decree of 26th December 2000 on childcare services, your child will be accompanied all day long by a team of state-qualified professionals:

- Childcare professionals (early learning teachers, childcare assistants)
- Healthcare professionals (nursery doctors, psychologists, psychomotor therapists, nurses)
- Service staff (cleaning and maintenance)



REMEMBER!

Our professionals never rush the learning process, instead letting children take their time and evolve at their own pace.

There is no official curriculum to be followed, no inappropriate or unnecessary pressure or over-stimulation as far as the child's development is concerned.

SETTLING-IN PERIOD

The partnership forged between the nursery staff and the child's parents is crucial to our learning process.



To ease the process, at the beginning of each term, we invite children and families to a **settling-in period**. This typically lasts a week and takes into account your child's emotional state and the nursery's organisation.

This time is beneficial to all: nursery staff, parents and the child, as they get to know one another, get accustomed to a new environment, new people, and a new organisation.



2- THE SETTLING-IN PERIOD Before joining the nursery, each family meets the director to discuss the nursery's organisation, internal guidelines and curriculum. Families are subsequently given a tour of the premises, meet the staff and receive a 'family welcome pack'.

Over the initial phase of settling, you will spend a few hours in the nursery, accompanied by a member of the nursery staff, to observe how your child reacts and adapts. You will then leave your child with that same staff member for a longer period each time, until you gradually leave them for a full day at the end of the week.



REMEMBER!
